*Age Requirements

All applicants for Orot must be born by October 31st, 2018

All applicants for Ganon must be born by October 31st 2017.

All applicants for Gan must be born by October 31st 2016.

All applicants for Mechinah must be born by October 31st 2015.

* The start date for the Orot full day will vary by child, ranging from post phase-in to post holiday (10/12/20). It will be decided on a case by case basis depending on your child's birthdate (must be 2 years old) and how s/he is adjusting.



ADMISSIONS TIMELINE

Application

Complete the online application by December 31st along with the \$150 application fee, a copy of your child's birth certificate and if applicable, a recommendation form.

Tours

Interview/Observation

All prospective students will be interviewed. Students for the Early Childhood program participate in a small playgroup where we observe the children interacting with one another. Students are encouraged to participate in varied activities in a warm, comfortable environment in order to provide us with insight about their readiness for our school.

First through Eighth Grade applicants are assessed in an individual meeting and screening to determine their grade level readiness.

Admissions Committee

Each applicant file is reviewed for acceptance by the Admissions Committee. Decision letters are sent out via email.

Tuition Assistance

Barkai offers Financial Aid to families who have a demonstrated need. Each family's level of assistance is based on its individual need and Barkai's available tuition assistance funds.

Barkai utilizes two tools to determine a family's need:

1. The FACTS Grant and Aid Management online platform
2. The Fund for Jewish Education ("FJE") Universal Tuition Assistance Application.

All families applying for Financial Aid should fill out all the requisite information both online on the FACTS website as well as on the FJE form. Applications for Financial Aid will not be evaluated if supporting documentation for both forms are not provided. All information provided will be kept in strict confidence.

Please note that we do not offer Financial Aid for students in Orot (2's) or Ganon (3's).

Financial Aid applicants will be notified of the committee's decision.

Late Applicants

Late applications are reviewed on a space available basis. We encourage you to submit all application materials immediately.

Enrollment Fee Payment and Terms

Payment of the Enrollment Fee is required to secure a student's position for the upcoming Academic Year. A student's enrollment is not guaranteed until the Enrollment Fee has been paid and their spot may be forfeited if not paid on time. The Enrollment Fee is non-refundable even if a student does not attend the Yeshivah or does not complete the Academic Year.

Tuition and Building Fee Payment and Terms

Tuition and Building Fee may be paid on one of 3 schedules:

1. Payment in Full by July 1, 2019
2. Two (2) equal Semi-Annual Installments due on July 1, 2019 and December 1, 2019
3. Ten (10) equal Monthly Installments due on the first of the month from July 1, 2019 through April 1, 2020

Applying online is the fastest and most direct method of submitting your application. It allows your institution to view your application electronically within minutes of submission.

Once you have signed in, you will have the ability to complete the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment application online.

After completing the online application you will need to mail or fax all the supporting documentation. The tax documents needed to verify your application are listed on the FGAA Checklist that is found online or in the paper application. Draft or Preview Copy tax documents will not be accepted.

Please allow 2 to 4 weeks for your application and supporting tax documents to be processed. We are unable to verify receipt of documents until they are scanned into our system, which takes approximately 2 to 3 business days. Faxed or copied applications will not be accepted. It is recommended that you keep a copy of your application for your records.

Application deadlines are set by the school or institution awarding the scholarships. If you are applying after a given deadline date, please contact your school or institution to ensure that your application will be accepted.

NOTE: Award decisions are not made by FACTS, but by the organization providing the scholarship.
